

Pono Pacific Invasive Algae Removal Project for Maunalua Bay

Position Descriptions

There are two positions available for the Pono Pacific Invasive Algae Removal Project:

1. Crew Leader Positions

Responsibilities include frequent communication with operational manager, oversee daily tasks of a crew of 10 to 20 individuals, coordinate with other crew managers, coordinate transportation of crews to and from the work site, recording waypoints with a GPS, recording the weight of algae removed, ensure a quiet, clean and safe work environment, ensure the invasive algae is removed from each work area, ensure proper care and storage of all equipment, and to ensure the safety and efficiency for a positive work environment.

Position Requirements:

- Excellent communication skills.
- Previous management/supervision experience of field crews.
- Computer literate, including Microsoft Excel and Word.
- Working knowledge of a Global Positioning System (GPS).
- Able to lift 50 pounds.
- Familiarity with near shore ocean conditions and Hawaii weather conditions.
- First aid and CPR certification a plus.
- Basic knowledge of marine animals and vegetation.
- Driver's license and a clean driving record.

Starting Pay: \$18 per hour.

2. Crew Member Positions

Responsibilities include manually removing invasive algae from Maunalua Bay, transport of material from the ocean to shore, processing the material on shore, communication with coworkers and crew managers, and ensure a quiet, clean and safe work environment.

Position Requirements:

- Good communication skills.
- Positive personality.
- Able to lift 50 pounds.
- Familiarity with near shore ocean conditions and Hawaii weather conditions.
- First aid and CPR certification a plus.
- Basic knowledge of marine animals and vegetation.
- Driver's license and a clean driving record a plus.

Starting Pay: \$11 - \$12 per hour, based on qualifications and experience.
