JOB DESCRIPTION

As a Farm Stand & Visitor Experience Associate, you will play a key role in both retail operations and visitor engagement at our farm. This position blends customer service, inventory management, and guided farm tours to create an enriching experience for guests. The ideal candidate is highly organized, detail-oriented, and passionate about agriculture, with strong interpersonal skills and the ability to balance retail responsibilities with educational outreach.

Farm Stand Operations & Inventory Management:

- Greet and assist customers at the Kuilima Farm Stand store, providing information about available products.
- Assist with inventory management by tracking stock levels, monitoring product demand, and helping to create and coordinate orders as needed.
- Organize backstock, receive shipments, and ensure timely stocking of merchandise in coordination with the farm stand supervisor.
- Maintain a clean, organized, and visually appealing farm stand, ensuring proper product rotation and freshness.
- Operate the point-of-sale system accurately, processing transactions and generating sales reports.

Tour Assistance:

- May occasionally lead and assist with engaging farm tours, sharing insights on farm operations, local agriculture, and sustainability.
- Continuously learn and incorporate Hawai'i's cultural and agricultural history into storytelling.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS

- Retail experience, preferably in food or farm-related sales.
- Knowledge of produce handling, food safety, or sustainable agriculture is a plus.
- Strong organizational skills, with experience in inventory tracking and stock coordination.
- Excellent communication skills and ability to engage with diverse audiences.
- Ability to lift up to 50 lbs and work in an outdoor environment.
